Currently, I am an assistant public advocate. Prior to that I was an assistant public defender for over 20 years. During that time, I was a misdemeanor and felony trial attorney, trying more than 25 cases. I also handled felony petitions to revoke probation and was a felony intake attorney. My experience has required my presence in the courtroom regularly, which I believe is a valuable asset for a district court judge to possess. In my present position, it has been imperative that I establish a good working relationship with opposing counsel and the court. I have had to hone my negotiaton skills and maintain a temperament that would be appropriate and expected for a judge.

Since 1999, I have been involved in establishing a drug court in Anchorage. It has been a very challenging and rewarding experience. It is very satisfying to help clients get clean and sober and thus become law-abiding citizens, attentive parents and empowered individuals able to get out of abusive relationships.

I have dedicated my legal career to public service. I enjoy working with the public and understand that working with the public demands a certain amount of patience and understanding.
