I also enjoyed working regularly with the public, both in communicating with witnesses and victims of crime, and in addressing citizens serving as jurors and grand jurors. Finally, I served as supervisor of the Anchorage D.A.'s Office misdemeanor unit for several months, and therein gained experience mentoring, organizing, and leading a group of young attorneys and staff.
