### Alaska Judicial Council Recommendation

### Judge Raymond Funk, District Court, Fairbanks

*I. Judicial Council Evaluation.* The Alaska Judicial Council, a non-partisan citizens commission established by the Alaska Constitution, finds Judge Funk to be *Qualified* and recommends unanimously that the public vote "YES" to retain him as a district court judge.

**II.** Summary of Evaluation Information. A survey of 2,927 attorneys in Alaska rated Judge Funk on sixteen categories that are summarized in the adjacent graph. Attorneys rated Judge Funk 4.2 on a scale of 5 on overall judicial performance. He scored 4.1 or better in all sixteen categories.

Ratings are based on a one to five scale. Five is the best rating and three is "acceptable."



A survey of 1,495 peace and probation officers in Alaska rated Judge Funk on twelve categories that are summarized in the adjacent graph. Peace and probation officers rated Judge Funk 4.1 on a scale of 5 on overall judicial performance. He scored 4.0 or better in all twelve categories.

A survey of jurors appearing before Judge Funk in 2002 and 2003 rated him 4.7 on a scale of 5 on overall performance. A survey of all court employees rated him 4.5 on a scale of 5 on overall performance.

The Council also completed a background investigation including a court records check, a disciplinary records check, a review of conflict of interest statements submitted to the court system and a review of financial disclosure statements submitted to the Alaska Public Offices Commission. Attorneys, peace officers, court employees and jurors were asked to submit written comments about the judge. The Council actively encouraged the public to comment, both in writing and in a statewide public hearing teleconference.

I am active in a number of administrative, educational and outreach activities. Currently, I am a training judge for the Fourth Judicial District. Recently, I was the primary organizer of the 2003 Second and Fourth Judicial District Magistrate Training Conferences. I was also a speaker for training programs at both the combined Second and Fourth District Magistrate Conferences and the First Judicial District Conference. I do annual reviews on magistrates and have been involved in hiring and disciplinary actions as well as training. I have also been involved in judicial conference organizing committees in the last few years.

For the past few years I have been a member of the Criminal Jury Instructions Committee. I am also a member of the Mentoring Committee, been trained as a mentor and currently served in that function with Judge Burbank. As part of the mentoring committee, I have been working on a number of outlines for what will eventually be a judicial electronic bench-book. At present, I have drafted outlines on DUI law, Criminal Rule 45, Pre-Accusation Delay, and a general Criminal Jury Trial Outline.

I served for a year on the Russian Rule of Law Committee and was involved in trainings for visiting Russian judges in June of 2002. Regrettably, my other activities have made me unable to be active recently in this area.

I am active in Judicial Outreach, serving on the Law Day committee in 2002 and being involved in school presentations from grade school to working with the University of Alaska Fairbanks Criminal Justice Department. Currently, I do at least a couple of presentations a month on a variety of legal topics. I am an occasional advisor for the Fairbanks and Delta Youth Courts.

Fairbanks does not have a therapeutic court and I have been actively involved in setting one up over the past year.

3. I greatly enjoy my role as a District Court judge in Fairbanks. I have tried over the five years I have been on the bench to improve myself as a judge and generally to improve the administration of justice in Alaska.

I repeatedly volunteer to do Superior Court cases and have done a number of felony trials as well as a couple of major civil trials. Since shortly after beginning as a judge, I have been doing a number of Superior Court civil case settlement conferences and get great satisfaction in helping resolve cases through settlement conferences, which frees up other judge from trials. Currently I handle over twenty settlement conferences a year.

I greatly enjoy being involved in judicial and magistrate education efforts. In creating outlines for the electronic bench-book and creating interactive training programs for conferences, I believe I am the one who benefits the most since the teacher needs to have the strongest grasp of the material to be able to teach it.

Lastly, I am excited to try to create an alcohol treatment court that follows successful models elsewhere in Alaska. Such a court creates the hope that our streets and homes will be safer from the devastation that alcohol related crimes cause each year.

#### Summary of Findings:

Judge Raymond Funk was evaluated by 197 Alaska Bar Association members who reported having direct professional experience with this judge. Of these 197 respondents, 89 (45.2%) had substantial and recent experience, 38 (19.3%) had moderate experience, 52 (26.4%) had limited experience, and 18 (9.1%) did not indicate level of experience. The mean score on the overall evaluation item was 4.2. The highest mean score was obtained on *conduct free from impropriety* or appearance of impropriety (4.3). The lowest mean scores were obtained on *legal and factual* analysis (4.1), equal treatment of all parties (4.1), ability to control courtroom (4.1), consideration of all relevant factors in sentencing (4.1), and talent and ability for cases involving children and families (4.1). Details are presented in the two tables that follow.

#### Summary of Findings:

Judge Raymond Funk was evaluated by 37 Peace and Probation Officers who reported having direct professional experience with this judge. Of these 37 respondents, 15 (40.5%) had substantial and recent experience, 8 (21.6%) had moderate experience, 12 (32.3%) had limited experience, and 2 (5.4%) did not indicate level of experience. The mean score on the overall evaluation item was 4.1. The highest mean scores were obtained on *conduct free from impropriety or appearance of impropriety* (4.2), *ability to control courtroom* (4.2), and *consideration of all relevant factors in sentencing* (4.2). The lowest mean score was obtained on *makes decisions without regard to possible public criticism* (4.0). Details are presented in the two tables that follow.
