My legal career in Alaska began as a Supreme Court law clerk to Justice Burke. I then worked for the Alaska Public Defender Agency as a trial lawyer and later as an appellate lawyer. I then served two years as General Counsel and Rules Attorney of the Alaska Court System; also served for two years on the Alaska Code Revision Commission revising the Alaska Corporations Code. I have been in private practice since 1984 and have served for 20 years as one of Alaska's commissioners to the Uniform Law Commission. I have substantial trial and appellate experience, civil and criminal. I have represented both plaintiffs and defendants in complex civil cases in state and federal court, including cases involving serious personal injuries; insurance coverage; constitutional rights; landlord-tenant; and adoptions. Most recently I tried a six-week jury trial in a complex multi-claim banking and securities case. Thank you for your consideration.
