I believe that I would be a good candidate for this position because I have first-hand experience in courtrooms across the state. I began my legal career as a law clerk for the superior court in Kenai. After clerking I became an ADA in Anchorage and took my first cases to trial in Unalaska. As an AAG, I have been to trial in every judicial district and I have seen a wide range of judicial styles. I think these experiences would be useful as a judge in Anchorage.

My time volunteering with the Alaska Legal Service Corporation and working at API gives me a somewhat unique perspective for a prosecutor. During my first summer in law school I worked at the ALSC in Fairbanks assisting indigent clients with basic legal issues. That experience helped open my eyes to some of the challenges faced by my fellow Alaskans in the legal system. Similarly, working with clients at API going through hard times taught me how important it is to treat others with empathy regardless of their present circumstances. These experiences have shaped my work as a prosecutor and would hopefully make me be a better judge.
