I am pleased with my overall performance during my first term on the bench. Of course there are things I wish I could redo or mistakes I've made that I wish didn't occur, but I use those as learning moments to ensure I become the best judge I can possibly be. I work everyday to ensure the people who appear before me feel heard and that they know that I take their legal issues seriously and do my best to resolve their dispute in a timely and fair manner. I believe that my interactions with litigants is overall a positive one and I strive to make their legal process as seamless and efficient as possible.

When I first took the bench there were many areas I had little or limited knowledge about, i.e. child protective cases, criminal matters, and family law cases to name a few. I have worked hard to learn as much as possible about these topics and believe I have been able to preside over these matters effectively. It was a steep learning curve (and a curve that is still going) but again, I work each day to make sure I have as much substantive information and knowledge that I can apply in the courtroom.

In addition to the administrative roles I have taken on, I currently preside over the felony drug and DUI therapeutic court along with Judge Easter. This is an incredibly rewarding court to be part of as it takes an entirely different approach to how criminal defendants are treated. The Court and team work together to address root problems of criminal behavior and to assist the participants in changing that behavior.
